

Most libraries lend out books, but the Human Library is different. It lets readers borrow "human books" for free. In fact, these "books" are living people.

The Human Library comes from Denmark. In 1993, Ronni and his friends started the organization "Stop The Violence" after a friend of theirs was knocked down and badly hurt one late evening. Then the organization set up the Human Library. They would like their readers to talk with all types of people and get a better understanding of each other. They believe it's a good way to help stop violence.

Since then, the idea of the Human Library has been welcomed around the world. In a Human Library, readers talk with the "books" to know them better. "Books" in the library are those who have special experience in life and then are different from common people. They may be homeless people, blind people, runaway children, men nurses, lawyers or police officers. These "books" cannot be taken out of the library building, and usually they can be "read" for only 30 to 45 minutes. A "book" can be shared by a group or family. Anyone who wants to be a "human book" has to pass an interview first.

In Taiwan, a college set up a Human Library in 2012. However, it's a little different from the ones in other countries. All its "human books" are the teachers in this school. They are only borrowed by the school's students to share what they are good at, for example, coffee art, birdwatching, or ice-skating. The library has been so popular that the college is thinking about getting "books" from outside the school in the near future.
