



A new law will soon change pets' lives in California, US. The law, AB 485, says that stores must get dogs, cats and rabbits from shelters. Pet shops should work with shelters or animal centers. In the future, the dogs, cats or rabbits you see in animal shops will be those which are saved. This means that people can't buy animals from breeders.

Some breeders try to breed a large number of puppies or cats for stores. Many of them don't take good care of these animals. They might keep too many of them in small, dirty cages. Also, they might not give them enough food. When they're sick, breeders might not send them to a vet, either. Breeders are not responsible enough, so that over fifteen million animals die under mercy killing every year.

Now, with AB 485, if stores buy animals from breeders and sell them, they'll get a **fine**. It'll be US\$500 for each animal. The rule change will happen in 2019. Let's hope the law will help stop terrible animal breeding.
