



**Part D Reading Comprehension**

August 2007 is the start of a new way for people to join a group discussion on social media. Commonly known as both the number sign and the pound sign, the symbol that looks like a tiny tic-tac-toe grid has now become the widely used **hashtag**.

It all started with a little idea from a former Google engineer named Chris Messina on August 23<sup>rd</sup> 10 years ago. His goal was to come up with a simple way to create groups of related messages. That way, people could find messages with a certain topic quickly and easily. At that time, Messina didn't know that he had invented a powerful tool that would go on to shape new culture and change the world.

People used hashtags on Twitter in the very beginning. Then, the simple hashtag and the idea behind it quickly found its way to Facebook, Instagram, and other social media. In 2014, it was even added to lots of big dictionaries. People everywhere have used it to bring attention to their personal interests, social causes, public movements and more. For example, the hashtag #NowPlaying lets people connect work from their favorite singers or bands. It has already been used over one billion times, making it the most popular of the time. The hashtag, #IceBucketChallenge, helped raise US\$100 million for the disease ALS. What's more, the tag #BlackLivesMatter has given African Americans a way to voice the living problems they face in the US.

With Twitter's 328 million monthly users sharing about 125 million hashtags, the little symbol will surely have people talk for years to come.
