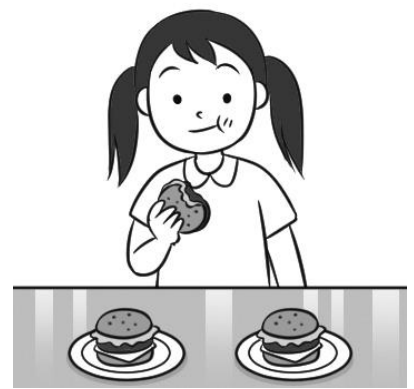

### Reviews

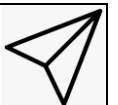
Don't forget to give the restaurant and the courier some good reviews. Besides, if the courier is great, you can also give him or her some tips.

## 【C】

Queen Elizabeth II was born Princess Elizabeth Alexandra Mary on April 21, 1926, in London and she had a younger sister, Margaret. In 1945, Elizabeth joined the Auxiliary Territorial Service to help in the war effort. She trained together with other British women to be an expert driver and mechanic. While her service work only lasted a few months, it gave Elizabeth a look into a different world.

When Elizabeth's grandfather George V died in 1936, his eldest son (Elizabeth's uncle) became King Edward VIII. Edward, however, was in love with American divorcée Wallis Simpson and had to choose between the crown and his heart. In the end, Edward chose Simpson and **abdicated** the crown.

The event changed the course of her life. Her father was crowned King George VI in 1937. Her mother became Queen Elizabeth. On King George's death in 1952, her mother became Queen Mother and she became Queen Elizabeth II. Elizabeth was crowned Queen Elizabeth II on June 2, 1953, in Westminster Abbey.

She married her cousin Philip Mountbatten on November 20, 1947, at London's Westminster Abbey. She was the mother of Charles, Anne, Andrew, and Edward and she was the grandmother of Princes William and Harry. She was the longest-reigning monarch in British history. Elizabeth died on September 8, 2022, at age 96. Her Majesty's coffin will be put to rest alongside her father, the Queen Mother and her sister Princess Margaret.
