This September, people in Iran protested for nearly a month for women's rights. It all started with the death of Mahsa Amini, a 22-year-old woman arrested by the police for breaking Iran's rules- women need to cover their hair with headscarves. However, this is not the first time people in Iran fight for women's rights.

Something similar happened in a soccer game in 2019. Shouting and waving a flag at a sporting game may be common for us, but not for women in Iran. Although Iran has one of the best soccer teams in the world, women in the country were not allowed to watch soccer games. Women who were soccer fans were very **dismayed** about it. They wanted to cheer for their favorite teams loudly. They said that soccer games shouldn't be only for men.

To fight for women's rights, Sahar Khodayari dressed like a man and tried to get into the stadium. However, she couldn't enter the stadium and ended up getting caught by the police. Sadly, she set herself on fire to protest the law. The news shocked the world. It made FIFA take action on the problem. They told Iran to allow women to watch the games in the stadium, or they wouldn't be able to host FIFA games. Iran agreed. In October 2019, women were able to walk into a stadium and watch a soccer game for the first time in nearly 40 years.

The desire to give or share has nothing to do with what we have. There are rich people who are difficult to share. There are also smart people who are **reluctant** to share the knowledge they have. However, there are simple people but always want to share with others. These are the real rich people. What makes us rich is not how much we have, but how much we can give to others.
