

On the night of February 6, 2023, an earthquake hit Turkey. The shaking began near Gaziantep. It caused serious damage to Kahramanmaraş, a city miles away from Gaziantep. Tens of thousands of people got hurt and the earthquake killed over 36,100 people. The number of the death is still growing. Around 216,347 people lost their houses and had no
