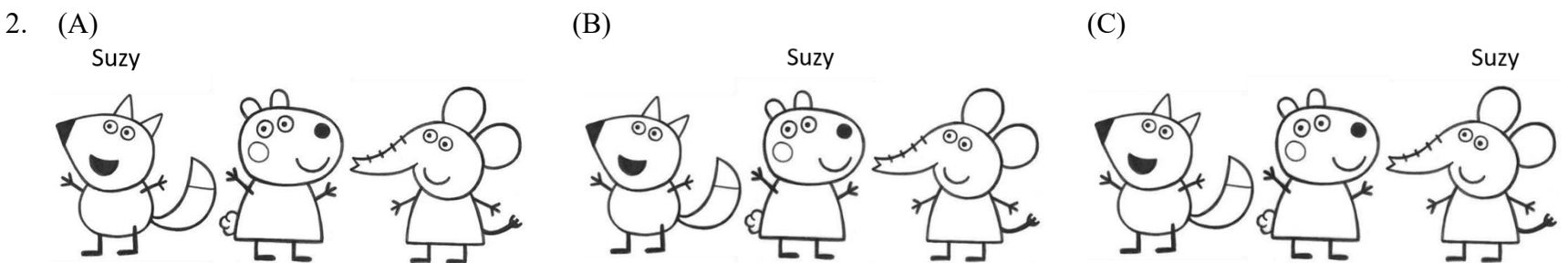

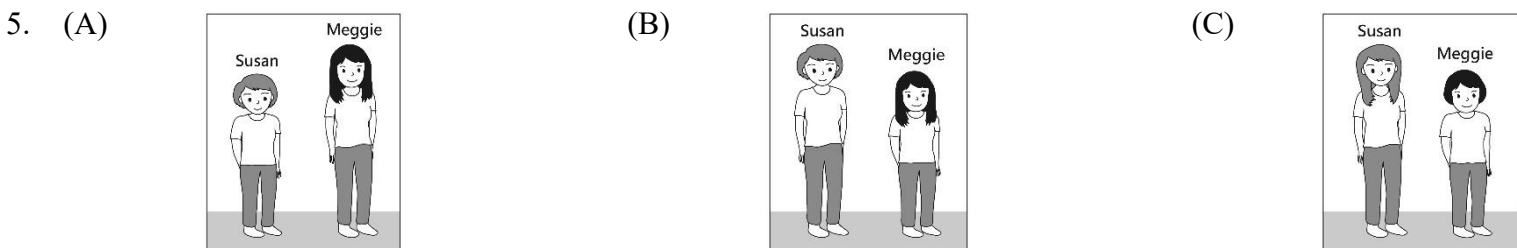
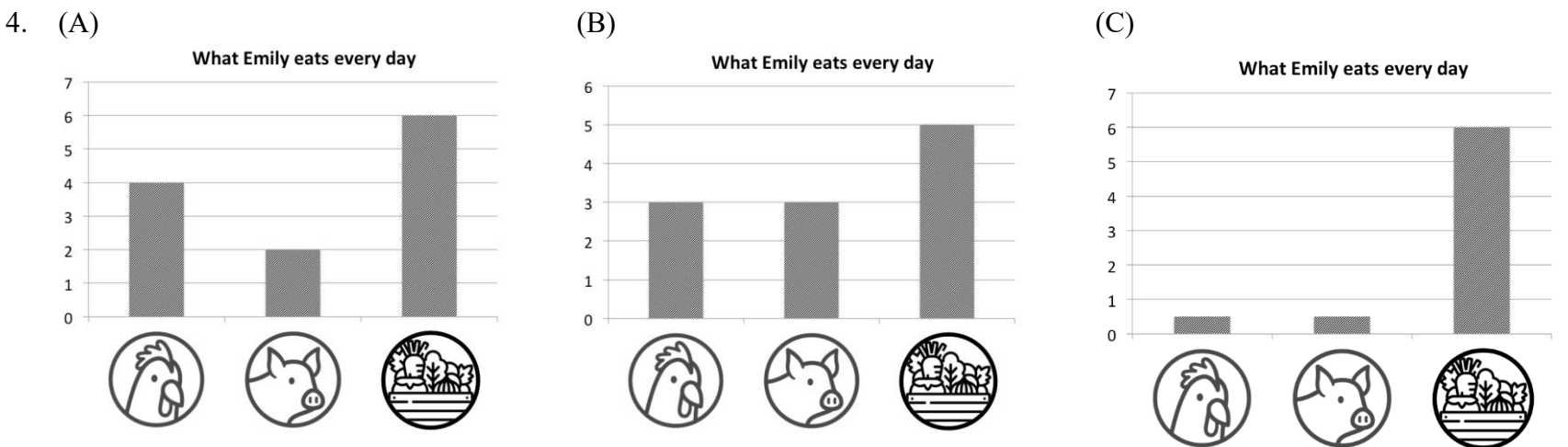

On the night of February 6, 2023, an earthquake hit Turkey. The shaking began near Gaziantep. It caused serious damage to Kahramanmaraş, a city miles away from Gaziantep. Tens of thousands of people got hurt and the earthquake killed over 36,100 people. The number of the death is still growing. Around 216,347 people lost their houses and had no place to live. They could do nothing but **relocated** to other cities. For example, some went to Istanbul, the biggest city in Turkey; some chose Hatay, a city near Syria. In fact, the earthquake also hurt Syria. However, it was not as lucky as Turkey. Less help from other countries arrived there. People in Syria felt scared and helpless.



To help Turkey, Taiwan sent a rescue team right after the earthquake. They also sent the FORMOSAT-5 to get more information. At the same time, lots of kind Taiwanese people gave money and things like beds, sleeping bags, and winter clothing there. By doing so, Taiwan showed the world that when a country is in need, Taiwan would like to help.

This earthquake showed us the power of nature. We should work together to get through difficult times like this.
