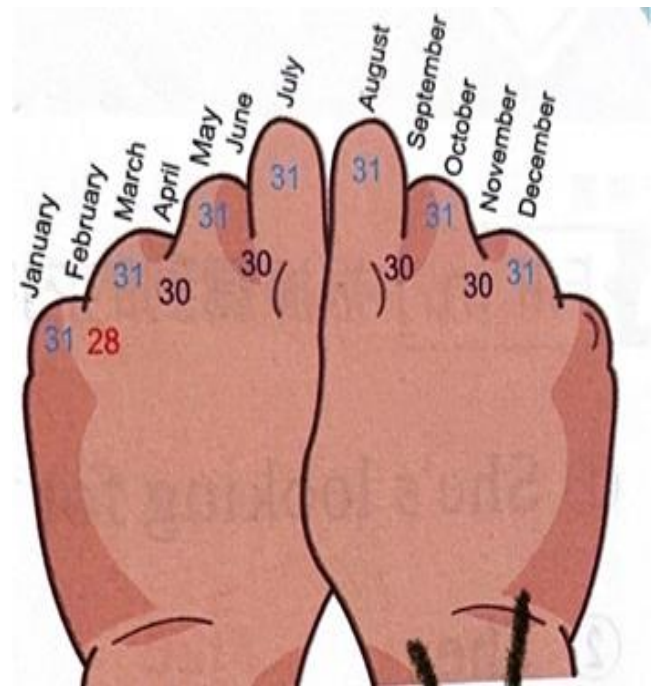

[C] The Story of Yeh Yung Chih

Taiwan's first Gender Equality Education Day is on Thursday, April 20th 2023, many years after the death of a boy, Yeh Yung-Chih. The day is to remember Yeh. He made people in Taiwan think more on gender equality.

Yeh was a 15-year-old student at that time. Many of his classmates laughed at him and even bullied him because of his looks and actions. Yeh acted more like a girl than a boy and enjoyed playing make-believe when he was a child. In junior high school, some of the students even had Yeh take off his pants to make sure he was a boy or a girl. Because of the bullying, Yeh could only use the school bathroom safely during class time, if possible.

On April 20th, 2000, people found that Yeh died in a school bathroom. Many people and Yeh's mother did not agree that Yeh's death was an accident. "He might be bullied and then killed," they thought.

After Yeh's death, the sense of "gender diversity" goes into the classroom. Now, every April 20th will remind people of Yeh's story and hope to push Taiwan to become more inclusive and warmer.
