

For a long time, people have always wished for AI robots to help with our work. But now that <u>it</u>'s happening, it may turn out to be more of a nightmare. We hoped AI robots would do our tasks, so we'd have more playtime. But when an AI robot takes over a job, someone might lose theirs and have to find a new one quickly. And finding a job that AI robots can't do is hard.

More and more jobs might be done by AI robots soon. By 2030, 45% of jobs in the USA could be done by them. This means AI robots could do lots of different jobs. For example, they may soon be working as nurses, teachers, clerks, cleaners, and even writers. Computers already write some news articles. Maybe even the article you're reading now was written by an AI robot!

As we get used to more AI robots helping out, we have questions about what it means for jobs and people's lives. AI robots doing boring tasks might sound good, but it brings challenges, too. Figuring out how to use AI robots while taking care of people who might lose their jobs is important for the future. After all, people want AI robots and humans to live together

When young children work, we call it child labor. The work is often not safe or not healthy for them. In the past, child labor was popular. Today, most countries think child labor to be wrong.

Being poor is the main reason children work. Families send their children to work because the family needs the money. Employers often like children more than adult workers because they can pay less money, and children are easier to control.

Some places in the world do not ask children to go to school or only let some children go. Some children may experience <u>discrimination</u>, or others may treat them unfairly. Some people choose to send girls or minority group members to work but not to school because they believe they don't need to learn.

The UK made laws in 1833 to limit child labor, followed by the US in 1938. In 1999, many countries of the UN agreed to stop bad child labor. The number of child laborers is decreasing worldwide. However, child labor remains a big problem in many parts of the world.
