



Acronym is a kind of abbreviation. For example, the first letters of each word from "National Aeronautics and Space Administration are "NASA," and "NASA" is a new word. "PIN" from "personal identification number" is the same. "PIN" is a new word, too.

Initialism is another kind of abbreviation. When acronym creates a new word, initialism doesn't. For example, "the United States of America" becomes "the USA." Other examples like "DIY" from "Do it yourself", "Idk" from "I don't know", "Ttyl" from "Talk to you later" are the same. We speak each letter aloud, and we pronounce the letters separately.
