



There are special ways to celebrate New Year's Day around the world. As 2024 ends, the first places to welcome the New Year are Tonga, Samoa, and Kiribati in the Pacific Ocean. They celebrate the New Year at 6 PM Taiwan time on December 31. You can fly from Samoa to American Samoa and celebrate twice because of time zones. Another interesting place is Cameron Corner, an Australian town at the meeting point of three time zones. Here, you can celebrate New Year three times in 1.5 hours by moving to different zones.

Kiribati is also very interesting because of its special place. Although it's almost directly south of Hawaii, Kiribati celebrates the New Year a whole day earlier than Hawaii. This makes it one of the first places in the world to welcome the new year. Kiribati used to be crossed by the International Date Line, which caused the same country to have different dates on different islands. In 1995, the government unified the time zone. This change draws many travelers who wish to celebrate the New Year early.
