Animals come in all shapes and sizes, from the really small to the really big. You may think that being big is better, and it does have many advantages. However, being small is good too! Smaller animals need less food to live, can give birth to babies more often and can hide in small places to run away from predators. Below are five of the smallest animals in the world.

Slender Blind Snakes

Slender Blind Snakes or Thread Snakes are the world's smallest snakes. They are about 11 cm long. In North and South America, Africa, and Asia, there are 87 different kinds of Slender Blind Snakes.

Kitti's Hog-Nosed Bat

The Kitti's Hog-nosed Bat or Bumblebee Bat from Thailand and Burma is the smallest bat. They are only 30–40 mm long and weigh only 1.5–2 g. They are about the same size as bumblebees and have a pig-like snout.

Paedocypris

Being only 7.9 mm long, Paedocypris are the smallest fish. In Indonesia's Sumatra Island, they can live with little water because of their small size.

Paedophryne amauensis

The smallest frog in the world is the Paedophryne amauensis. First found in New Guinea in 2009, it's a new kind of frog that doesn't even have a common name now. With a body size of just 7.7 mm long, Paedophryne amauensis is the smallest vertebrate.

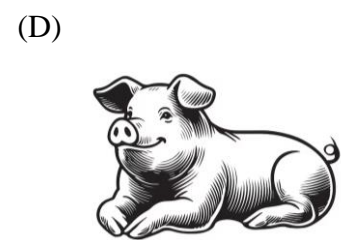
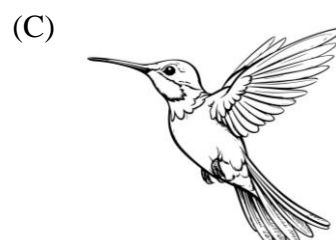
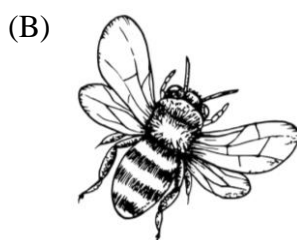
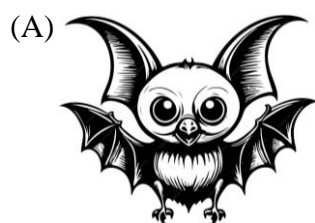
Bee Hummingbird

The Bee Hummingbird is the smallest bird and the smallest warm-blooded vertebrate. It is 5.7 cm long and weighs 1.8 g.

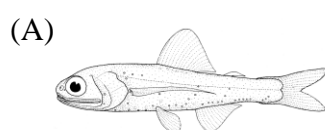
