













2. Formosan Black Bears Got Rescued in Eastern Taiwan

This week, the Hualien Forestry and Nature Conservation Agency rescued a mother black bear and her baby.

On March 27, a rope trap caught a mother black bear in Zhuoxi Town, Hualien. A team of 20 rescue workers arrived quickly and set her free. They took her to a safe place for medical care. She weighed 58 kg and felt very thirsty. Her front left paw was a little hurt. Her condition was not serious, so she would get well soon.

A baby bear climbed a tree nearby. The team set up cameras and traps to catch her safely. On March 30, the baby bear walked into one of the traps. The next morning, the team caught her and brought her to the same safe place as her mother. The baby bear was a girl bear and weighed 11.5 kg. Her body was strong and healthy. People think she might be the mother bear's baby. A mother-child test will check it later.

If anyone finds any bears and reports them to the government, he/she will get NT\$3,000 (US\$90) as a prize. Hunters and farmers should not use rope traps because traps catch and hurt black bears at the same time. We don't want to hurt Taiwan Black Bears at all. We should always provide different ways to keep animals safe.
